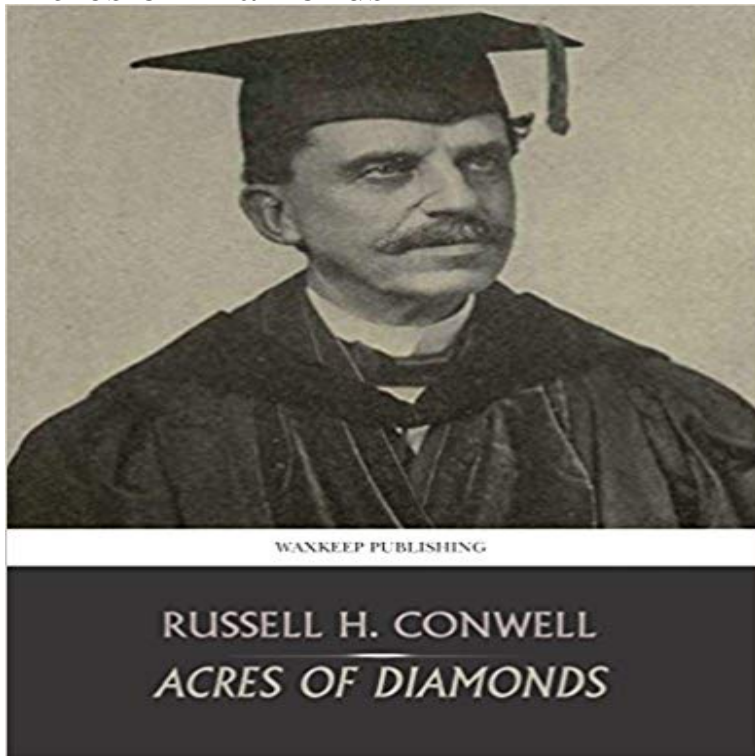


# Acres of Diamonds
