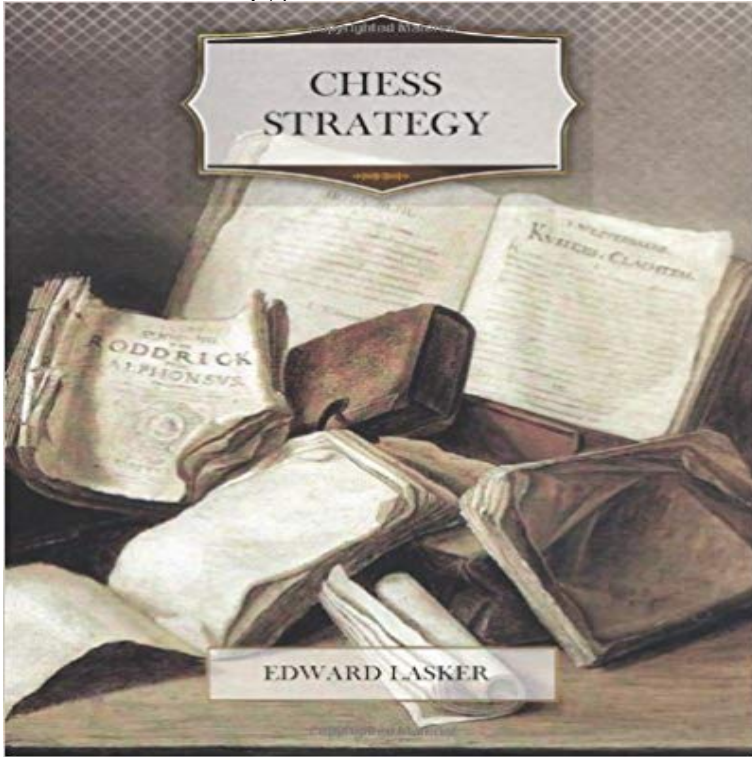


# Chess Strategy
