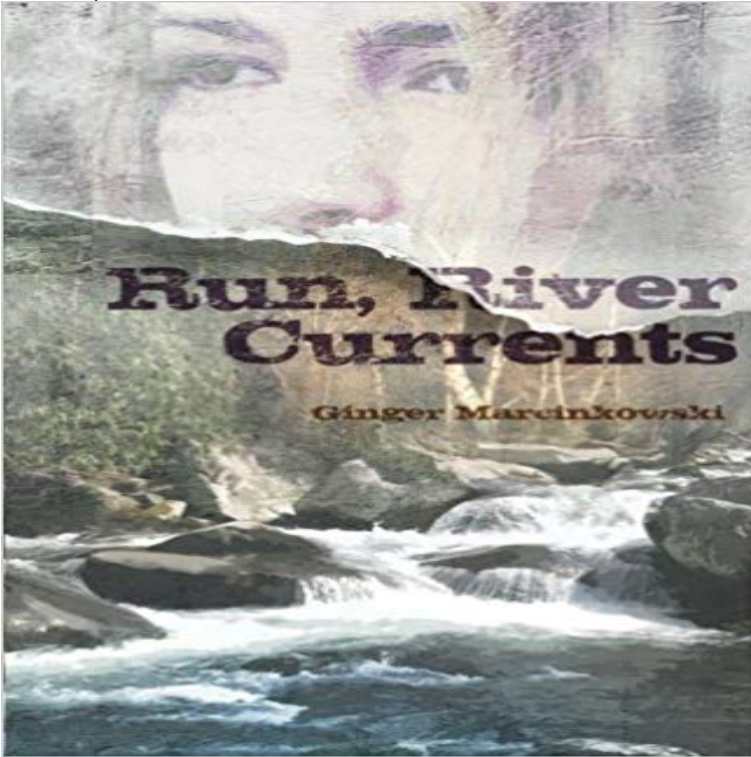


Run, River Currents
