


Frankly Speaking: A Novel of Friendship Courage and Survival

Only this friendship is threatened by a secret Frank has kept and a string of robberies to local businesses in the Portland area that has the Police department suspicious and on edge. These worlds collide during the day-long walk. Only for Ted and Frank, the walk turns into running; running for their lives. To survive, both must build trust, confront prejudice, deal with their inner fears, and neither Frank nor Ted knows how it will end. Frankly Speaking takes the topic of prejudices and stereotypes, be it black or white, African American or Caucasian, and also confronts bullying head on.
