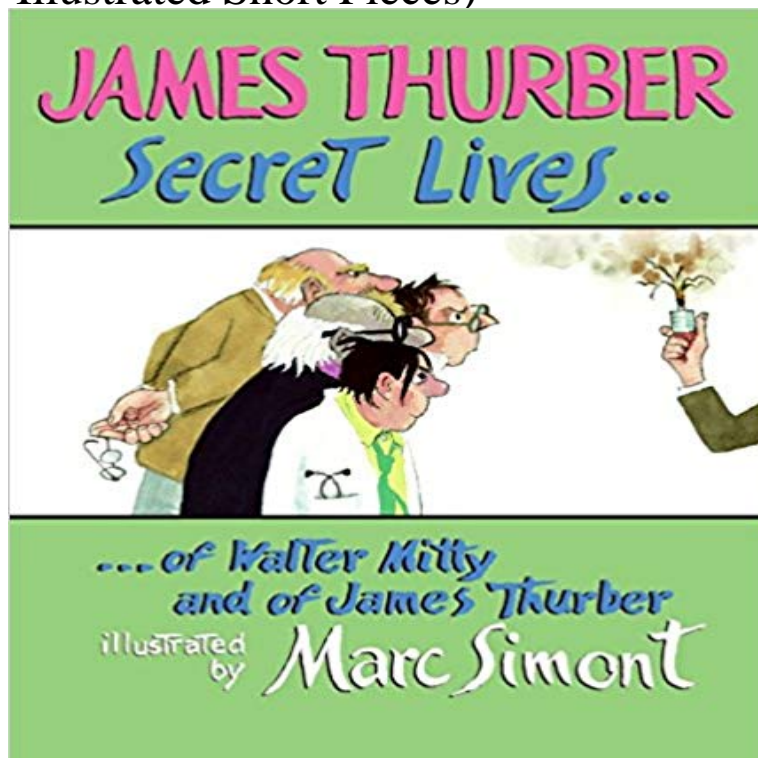


Secret Lives of Walter Mitty and of James Thurber (Wonderfully Illustrated Short Pieces)
