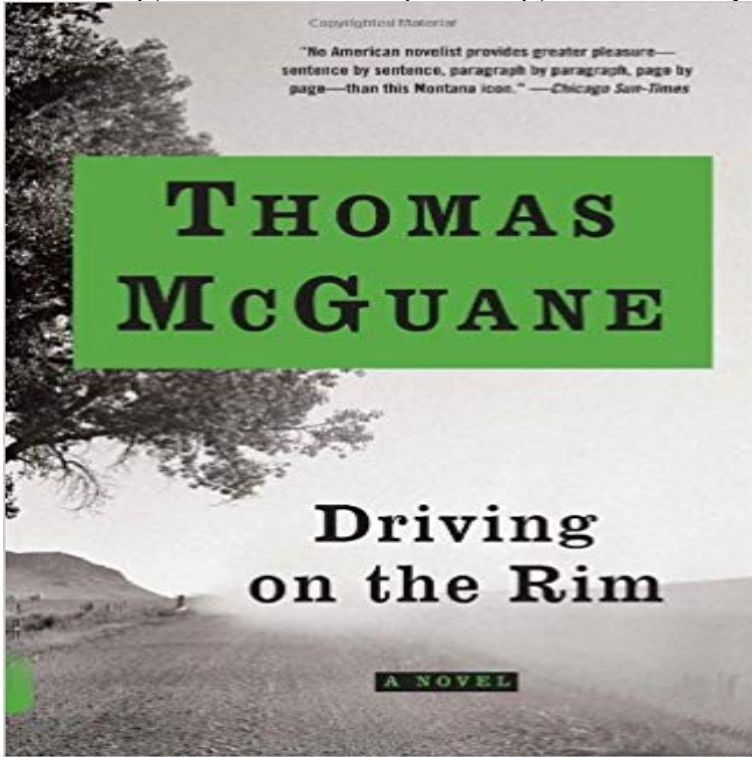


Driving on the Rim (Vintage Contemporaries)
