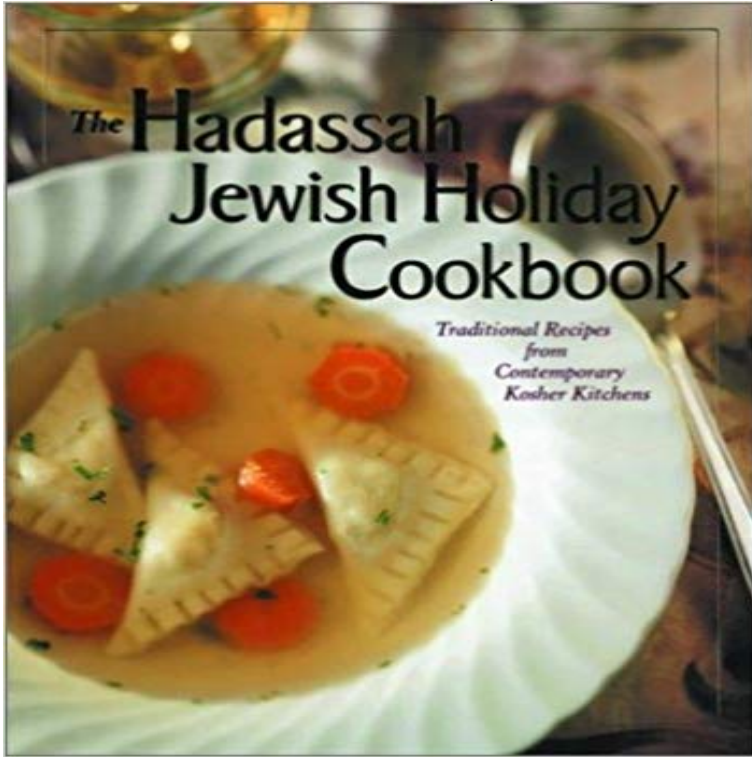


# Hadassah Jewish Holiday Cookbook
