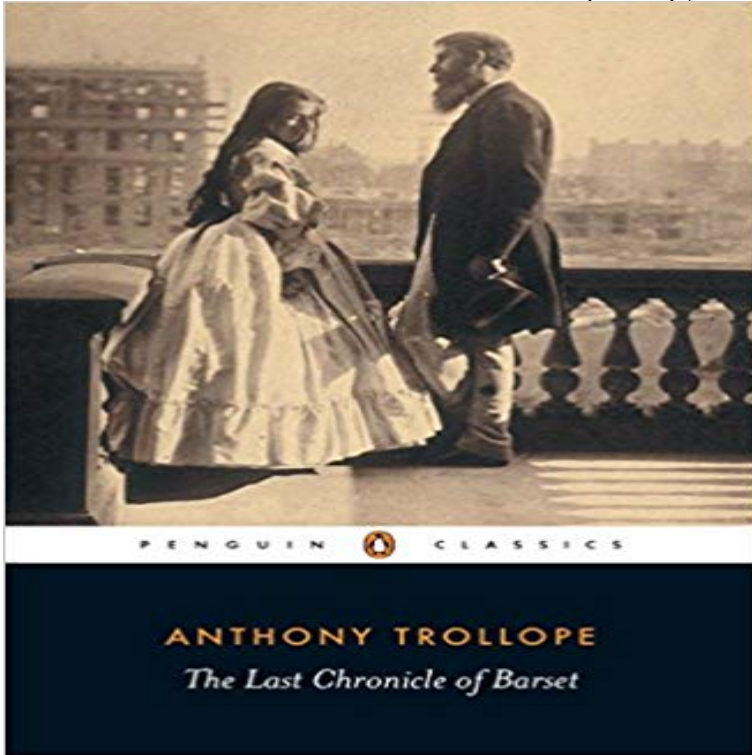


The Last Chronicle of Barset (Penguin Classics)
