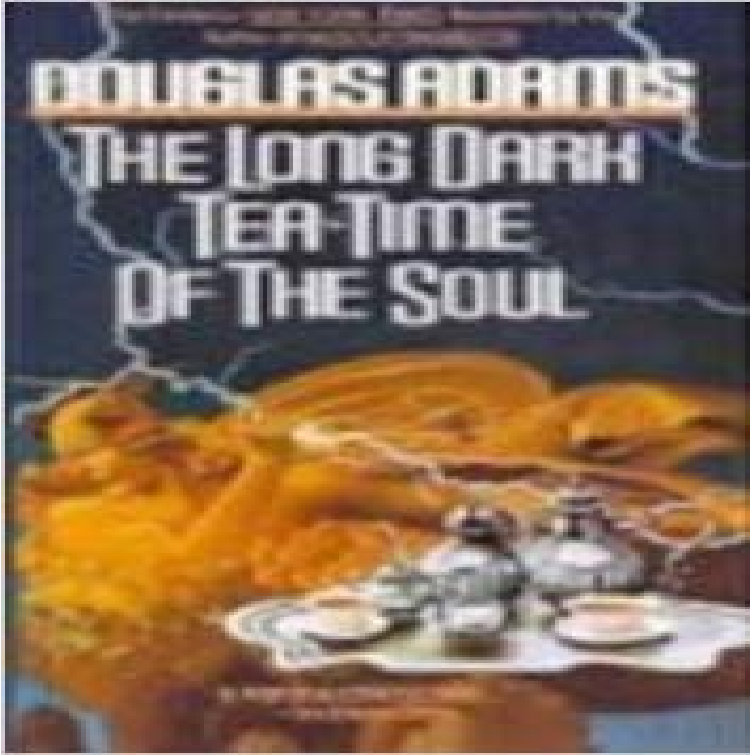


Long Dark Tea Time of the Soul
