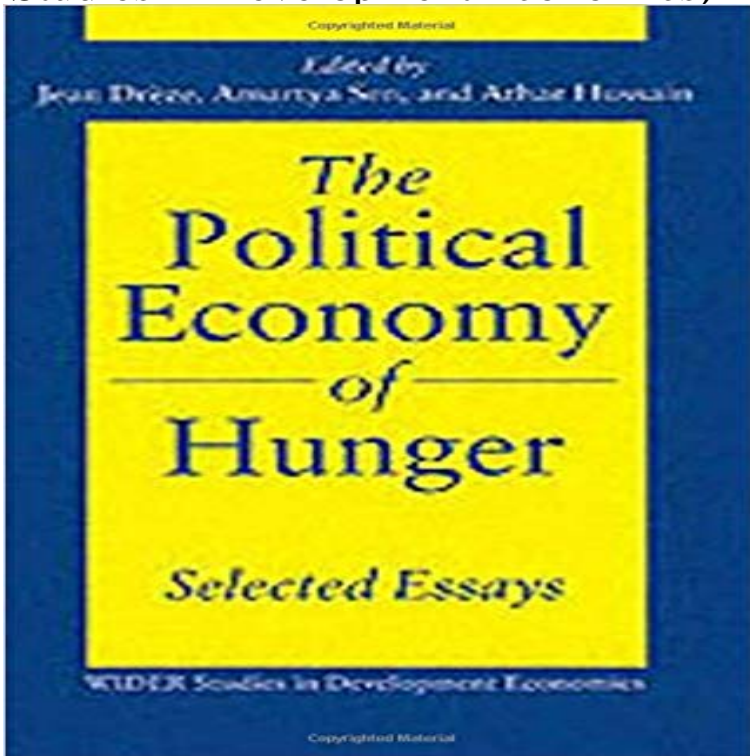


The Political Economy of Hunger: Volume 3: Endemic Hunger (WIDER Studies in Development Economics)

In addition to general analyses, the book examines the international relevance of a number of specific country experiences in Asia, Africa, and Latin America.
